Cllr Clegg confirmed she will lead this but will require volunteers to help.</p> <p><u>Village Show - 7th September</u> Cllr Pira confirmed that categories set up, stallholders are the next step. If anyone can spare 45 minutes to help on the gates please let the committee know.</p> <p><u>Christmas Fair and Lights - 23rd November</u> The clerk reported that work has started on this and that stallholders have been instructed with 24 stalls confirmed</p> <p><u>VE day</u> New event. The VE working group met and plan to have flags around the streets like the coronation and ask shop owners if it was ok to put up the flags. Bunting to be loaned to shops for window displays. A request for Poppies to be knitted and crocheted and to be dropped off by the 2nd May to be made into a display over the Grange. A VE flag will be raised on 8th May. at 6.30pm the ringing of the bells and lighting of a lantern by the War Memorial. Contractor to be asked to install the flag poles and flags on the shops. Expected spend of £400.</p>
